IMS Crime Wizard delivers unprecedented levels of operational efficiency to police forces utilising IMS. IMS Crime Wizard simplifies the data entry process for users by guiding them through the crime input process ensuring that correct recording procedures are followed, high quality data is inputted and efficiency (through diminished “re-keying”) is greatly increased.

IMS Crime Wizard delivers significant time savings of between 30-60% on previous crime recording systems. Recording speeds are even further reduced when Crime Wizard is integrated with the Force’s Command and Control system(s).
