

IMS Intelligence Wizard is the faster way to submit, analyse and link intelligence.

IMS Intelligence Wizard has been developed to make it easy for all police officers to submit intelligence and reduce the time required for Local Intelligence Officers to assess intelligence, create entities and links and disseminate sanitised intelligence. This, in turn, reduces the time-lag between receiving and acting upon intelligence.

Benefits

- **Time savings** – takes less time to enter intelligence and less time to process and link intelligence
- Reduction in time required to input intelligence and create entities & links, reducing the backlog of intelligence processing leading to **more immediate action upon intelligence**
- More **reliable intelligence** – the system helps to ensure that all relevant details are entered into an intelligence log and the omissions are quickly rectified
- Better quality intelligence leads to **more effective intelligence-led policing**
- Allow intelligence officers to more **quickly assess, act on and disseminate intelligence**


Intelligence Input—The Intelligence Input tool allows any police officer with access to a computer to submit intelligence to the intelligence database. It improves efficiency and usability in a number of ways:

- Allows officers to save partially completed intelligence logs to return to later
- mandatory fields make it easy to tell what information must be entered
- can be accessed on any computer via internet browser

Workload Dashboard—Intelligence Officers can view all submitted intelligence logs from the Workload Dashboard and perform the following tasks:

1. **Assess intelligence**
Assess the quality of the intelligence and return intelligence logs to the originating officer if they are incomplete or insufficient
2. **Sanitise intelligence**
Remove the names of informants or any overtly subjective information.
3. **Search the database**
Automatically search the intelligence database to establish if people, vehicles, property etc. mentioned in the intelligence already have records (see Fig. 2).
4. **Index entities**
Automatically create new entities (people, places, property) if they don't already exist in the database
5. **Link intelligence and entities**
Automatically link the intelligence log to entities and visually create links between entities (e.g. link people to other people, buildings, vehicles) (see Fig. 3).
6. **Disseminate**
After completing all the required tasks, the intelligence is made available to all relevant personnel to allow appropriate action to be taken quickly.

Intelligence Input

Allow any police officer to submit intelligence. The simple intelligence form guides officers through the intelligence submission process, helping to make sure that all relevant details are completed.

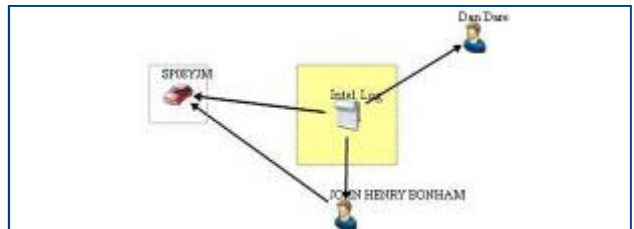
Workload Dashboard

Intelligence officers are presented with a list of all outstanding intelligence tasks, allowing them to prioritise and manage their workload.



Entity Creation and Linking

Intelligence Officers can quickly highlight all entities (nominals, addresses, vehicles etc.) in the intelligence log, triggering a search of the database.



Visual Link Creation

Intelligence Officers are presented with an interactive entity linking tool, allowing them to quickly create links between entities with the click of a button.
